## Become a Zip-Line Canopy Tour Guide for WVU!

Represent WVU, become a paid employee and guide participants at both the WVU Outdoor Education Center and the Boy Scouts of America's Summit Bechtel Reserve this summer.

In order to become qualified, students must successfully complete one of the following trainings:

1. **RPTR 326 - CANOPY TOUR FACILITATION, 3 CREDITS-SPRING SEMESTER**
  - A. Held every Tuesday between 1:00 p.m. and 4:15 p.m. (Transportation times to OEC included)
2. **SPRING BREAK WEEKLONG CANOPY TOUR FACILITATION, NO CREDIT, March 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>**
  - A. Held at the WVU OEC throughout WVU's spring break. 8am-6pm each day.
3. **WEEKLONG CANOPY TOUR FACILITATION TRAINING, NO CREDIT, MAY 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>**
  - A. Held at the WVU OEC the week after finals. 8am-6pm each day.

**CERTIFICATION:** All students seeking to become a guide must complete each training and pass certification. Certification dates for each training above will be held May 12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>

**COST:** The typical cost for certification is \$200.00. This fee is waived for all students participating in the 2017 Summit Bechtel Reserve.

**COMPENSATION:** Selected students will be hired as a hourly worker through Adventure WV. Typical wages start at \$10.00 an hour. Students participating in the 2017 Boy Scout Jamboree will receive a \$500.00 stipend and receive free housing and meals during the Jamboree (July 16<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>). Students will have the ability to work both positions throughout the summer.
